

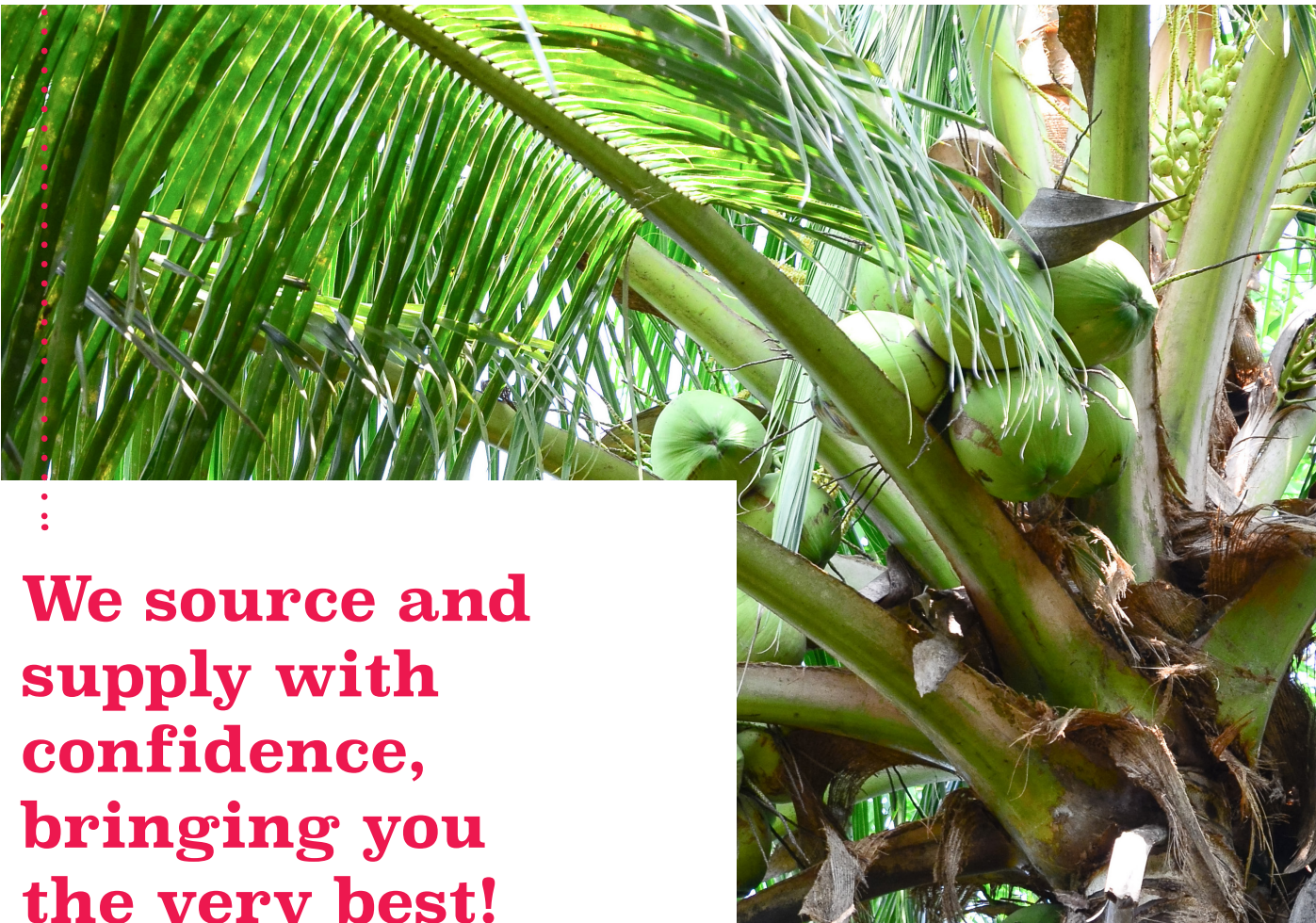

Fresh Special Close Shaved Young Drinking Coconut

Our fresh special close shaved young drinking coconuts are grown in the Ben Tre region of Vietnam, on the Mekong Delta. Available all year round they are one of our best selling products.

They come in a choice of cut finishes:

- **Traditional Diamond Cut** - Wrapped.
- **Ready to Drink** - Close shaved, with 'insert straw' sticker, wrapped.
- **Ready to Drink** - Close shaved in a cardboard ring, wrapped with 'insert straw' sticker and plastic straw in the base. Also including the option to choose your own brand design.

Fresh Dragon Fruit (White Flesh)

Synonymous for its red skin and white flesh, our fresh dragon fruit is the foundation from which the company was built.

Grown in the Binh Thuan region of Vietnam, our dragon fruit, or 'pitanaya' to the locals, is one of the most amazing and delicious fruits of the cactus family. It has the sweetness of kiwis, strawberries and pears, and can be used in all types of food and drinks, from creams and juices, to yogurts and sorbets, and many more.

There are two main dragon fruit seasons. The dry season runs from December through to May and the rainy season from June to November. Special lighting is used out of season to stimulate the flowering (see photo below).

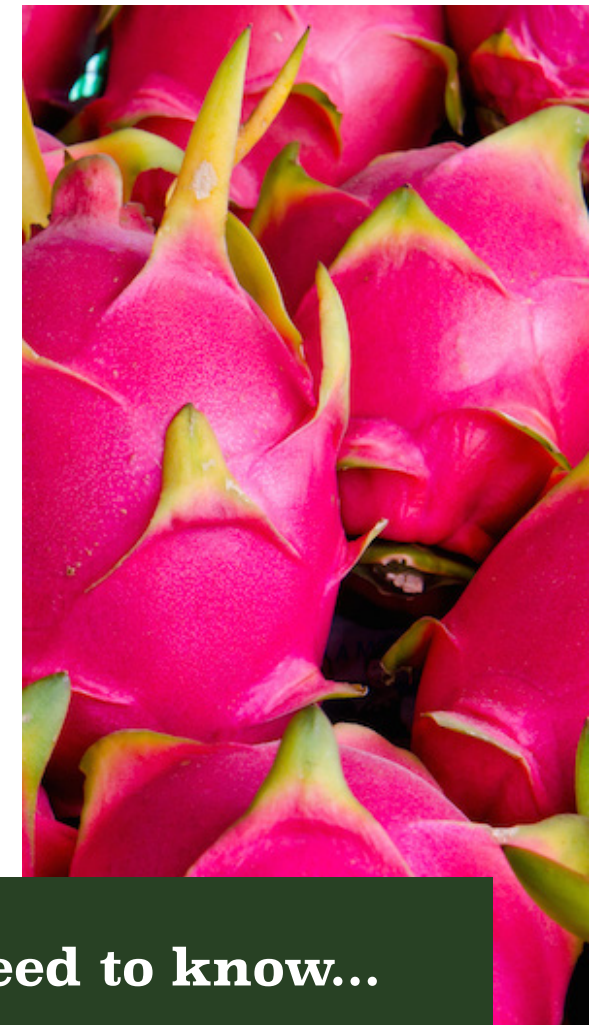

Fresh Rambutan Varieties (Thai or Java)

Grown in the Ben Tre region of Vietnam, our fresh rambutan is a member of the lychee family, famous for a sweet and sour, juicy flesh. The outer hairs often darken, however the internal fruit is perfect.

The Java variety is the main crop, however the Thai variety is also available.



Not a lot of people from the Western part of the world are familiar with the rambutan fruit, mostly because it is native to Malay countries, such as Malaysia and Vietnam. It is primarily known for its similarities with the lychee and the longan fruit, particularly its transparent-whitish flesh and the seed in the middle. This is because these fruits are actually close relatives.

Although they are similar, the outer cover or shell is what sets these three fruits apart. Nevertheless, the rambutan fruit can be easily identified because of its green and red spikes that resemble hair, which is interesting because the name 'rambutan' comes from the Malay word for 'hair'.

Fresh Longan (Dragons Eye)

Our fresh longan has a light brown smooth outer skin and is also called the dragon eye fruit. The flesh is white and there is a black seed in the middle, hence the name, 'dragon eye' fruit. While they all have a black seed in the middle, the ratio of seed to fruit is almost perfect in a longan and looks like an eyeball when cut in half. This fruit has a more tart and distinctive flavour.

Purple Sweet Potato

Purple sweet potatoes are treats for the eyes and a complete powerhouse of nutrition's they are rich in vitamin A, vitamin C, potassium and fibre. Sweet potatoes are high in vitamin A, vitamin C and manganese. They are also a good source of copper, dietary fibre, vitamin B6, potassium and iron. Sweet potatoes are known to improve blood sugar regulation and some studies have discovered significant antibacterial and antifungal properties



Mangosteen

Mangosteen is a super fruit that's been harnessed for centuries for therapeutic and nutritional purposes in South East Asia. The fruit is used to treat infections, Irritable Bowel Syndrome, diarrhoea, dysentery, and even wounds. It is a powerful antioxidant, anti-inflammatory, antibacterial, antimicrobial, anti-viral, and rich source of catechins. Mangosteen has a wealth of phenolics and tannins which encourage free-radical scavenging which may prevent cancer, inflammatory responses to foreign compounds, and may even slow the aging process.



Pomelo

The typical pomelo is much larger than the grapefruit, and also has a much thicker rind. It tastes like a sweet, mild grapefruit (believed to be a hybrid of Citrus maxima and the orange). [7] The flesh has none, or very little, of the common grapefruit's bitterness. The enveloping membranous material around the segments is bitter, considered inedible, and usually discarded.
